A – Reading:

Comprehension of an unseen passage. The passage may be factual, discursive or literary.

B – Writing:

1. Formal Letter (Editor/Placing an order/Inquiry/Complaint)
2. Article Writing

C – Grammar:

Subject Verb Agreement, Tenses, Modals, Determiners, Reported Speech, Active and Passive Voice, Phrasal verbs
